



Board of Directors

There are currently nine Directors on the Board of Directors for the Minnesota Chapter of LAI, including those who serve in officer positions. The Board meets as needed, approximately 5-6 times per year, usually over lunch at Midland Hills Country Club. The Board seeks to support the goals of LAI by fostering thoughtful conversations around land economics in a uniquely interpersonal program setting.

The primary responsibilities of the Board, in which all Directors participate, are identifying program topics and speakers and identifying and nominating new LAI chapter members. Directors also seek ways to encourage member retention and program participation. Board members should attend the majority of the LAI programs, which generally number five through the course of a year.

The Board is ably served by our Chapter Administrator, Pat Arnst. Administrative tasks are few for most Board members. The President and Treasurer of the Board have greater responsibilities with respect to Chapter administration.

Our Board meetings are relaxed, collegial and productive. Board membership enhances the opportunities generally provided by LAI to engage with professionals from multiple disciplines in the land economic fields.
